PCR Services Corporation (**PCR**) biologist Crysta Dickson conducted the weekly fence monitoring for the ASCON landfill project site on March 15, 2011. Ms. Dickson was escorted by Steve Howe of Project Navigator, Ltd.

The entire project site was driven and all fencing (both construction and chain-linked) was inspected to ensure fencing was intact and no impacts have occurred to the disturbed coastal salt marsh or southern tarplant (*Centromadia parryi* ssp. *australis*) populations to be avoided and preserved.

At the time of the inspection, all fencing was intact and no damage to the disturbed coastal salt marsh or southern tarplant was observed.
