Community Safety

Nothing is more important to our team than the health and safety of the Huntington Beach community as we engage with our neighbors to finish the cleanup of the Ascon Landfill Site.

Air data collected to date on the Site and in the surrounding neighborhood have confirmed there have not been any chemicals detected by our monitoring at levels that present a risk to the community. In response to community concerns, we are evaluating enclosures and tenting for future excavation activities.

Ascon's unique Site challenges:

- Nearby residences, schools, park and businesses
- Proximity to traffic signal and busy intersection
- Power lines
- Uneven terrain (Steep Slopes/Berms)
- Coastal Weather Conditions (Strong Winds)

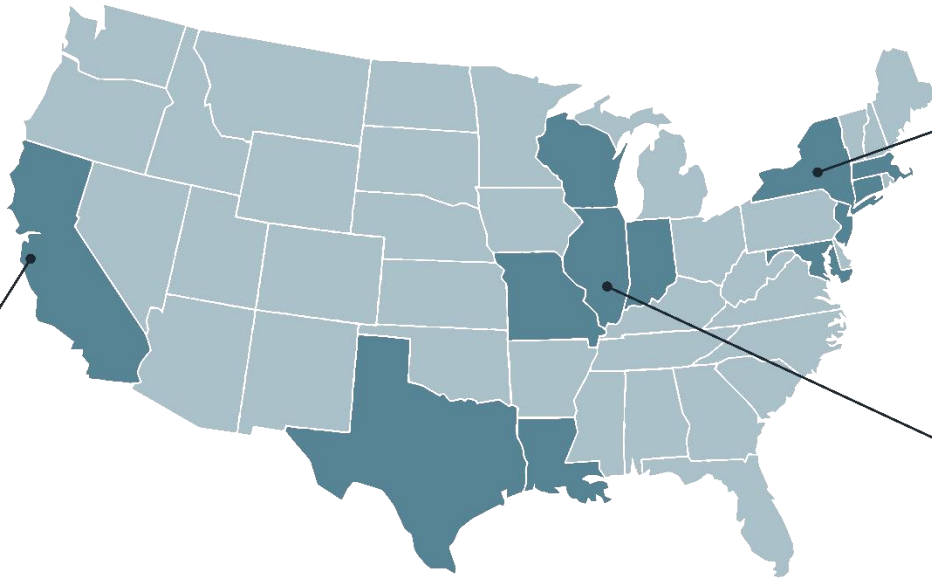


Tenting and Enclosures Benchmarking

We benchmarked the best available tenting technology through vendors, site managers and companies with tenting at sites nationwide.



Key finding: All existing tenting excavation projects we benchmarked are on flat terrain sites.

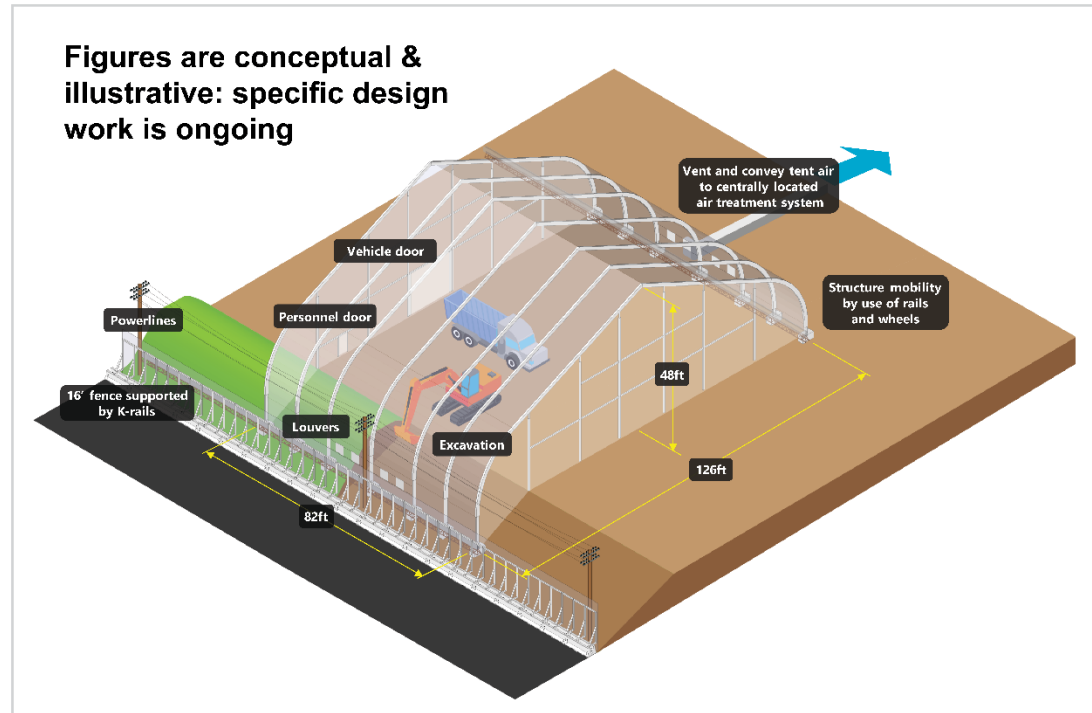


An Innovative Approach to Tenting

Criteria for selection:

- ✔ Tent must be stable on variable terrain to be safe for the public and workers
- ✔ Must stand up against wind and weather
- ✔ Be adaptive to changing work zones and operational needs

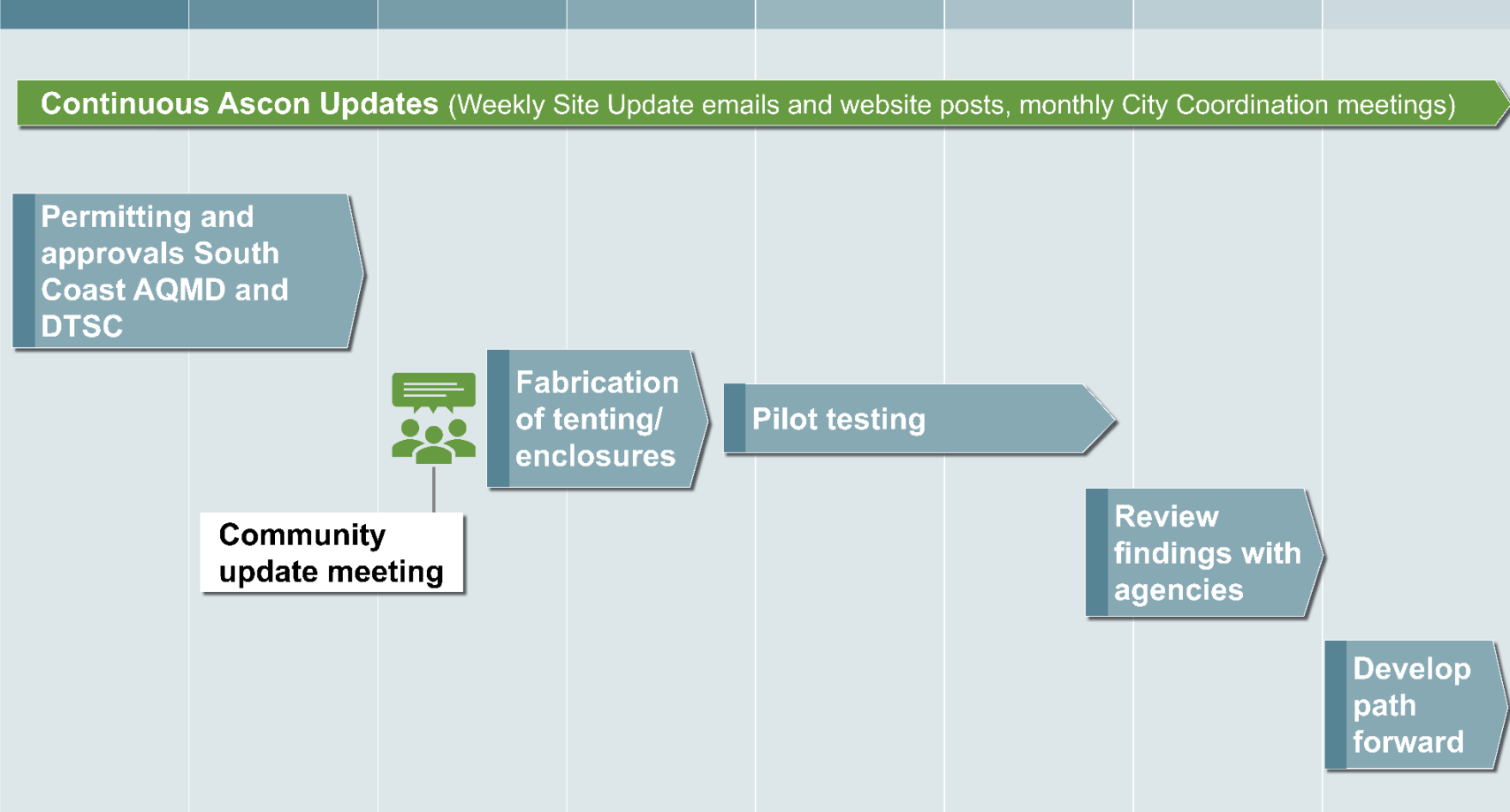
Please note: Installation of tenting and enclosures will require excavation for structural support, footings and rail features.



Other tools to supplement tenting:

- Canopies
- Posi-shell
- Odor Suppressant Foam
- Misting
